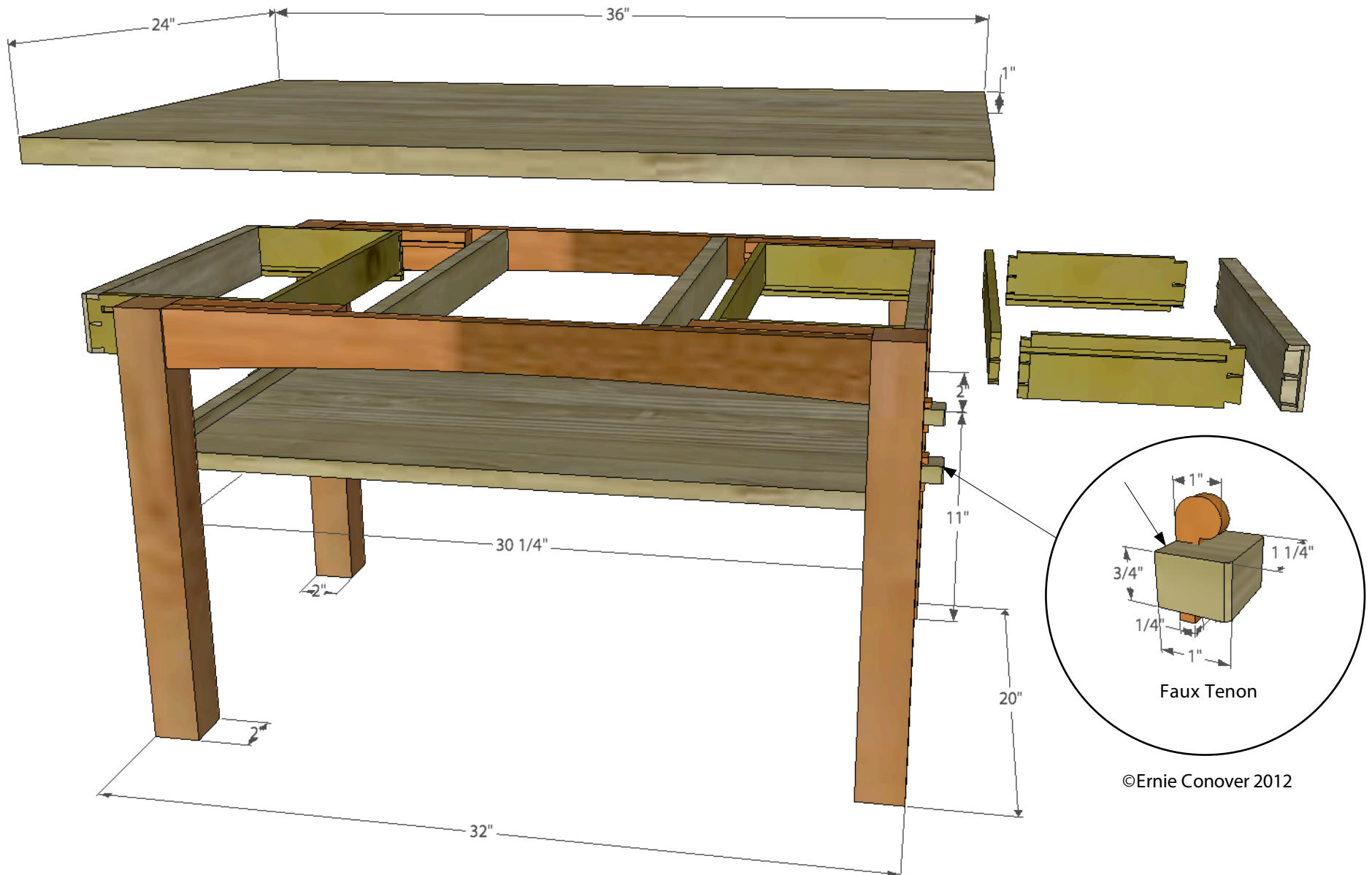


Arts & Crafts Coffee Table

In this five day class you will learn a gaggle of machine techniques in the building of an Arts & Crafts style coffee table from white oak. Other than the 1" thick top, all parts of the table are from $\frac{3}{4}$ " material. A Festool Domino machine will be used to tenon the aprons to the legs. The faux tusk tenons will be screwed to the bottom rails. The two side hung drawers will be hand dovetailed. Finishing will be with hand planes and orbital sanders. Ernie will lead the class through fuming the white oak with ammonia to achieve the chocolate color associated with Mission Style and finishing with padded white shellac and back tinted wax. A great class with a coffee table to grace your living room as the payoff.
